

2024 U.S. National Survey on the Mental Health of LGBTQ+ Young People The Trevor Project

For the sixth year, the U.S. National Survey uncovers the reality that there is a significant association between anti-LGBTQ+ victimization and disproportionately high rates of suicide risk — and that far too many young people struggle to access the mental health care they need.

""Coming out" is only one stage in one's growth. An "out" person is not necessarily a healthy one, though being in the closet can only reenforce ones emotional stress.

"Coming out" and "being out" do not solve the many psychological issues that discrimination has internalized, much less the normal issues everyone of every orientation has when growing up in our kind of society with its flawed child-rearing methods. That requires further work through supportive groups, examining one's issues, and even professional help." 39% of LGBTQ+ young people seriously considered attempting suicide in the past year — including 46% of transgender and nonbinary young people. LGBTQ+ youth of color reported higher rates than White peers.

Safe Zone Training Continues

On June 1st we did a Safe Zone Training for Caroline Furnace Lutheran Camp's summer staff and board. The counselors that will be there for the summer were a diverse group from many parts of the world and they wanted to understand how to approach a safe space for the young campers that will be in their care for a few weeks at a time during the summer months. Those campers will be away from parents and will have the opportunity, if they are questioning their identities, to be in an affirming environment and Caroline Furnace Lutheran Camp wants to make the kiddos feel like they can be who they are with no judgment and they will honor the child for their words. This is huge! And we need for other churches and organizations to adopt this perspective so that the hate and judgement is dispelled and the mental health issues don't have a chance to set in.
